Runners run in distance-descending order (i.e. 500m, 400m, 300m, 200m, 100m, 50m) Clubs can enter a maximum of 4 teams

Format: Race will involve 5 turning flags: 25m (50m), 50m (100m), 100m (200m), 150m (300m), 250m (500m)

Points scoring

Individual 5,4,3,2,1 (flags, sprints)

Teams: 10, 6, 4, 1 (beach relay)

Mega Relay: 20, 18, 16, 14, 12, 10, 8, 6, 4, 2 (top 10)

Top overall club will be awarded the Otago Beach Classic Award
